



## KOREAN CHICKEN

### **HEATING INSTRUCTIONS: 2+ Servings**

*If frozen, defrost in refrigerator overnight.*

1. Preheat oven to 375°F (350°F convection).
2. Place Korean chicken, uncovered, on middle rack of oven.
3. Bake for 15 minutes, then gently toss the chicken and heat another 15 minutes.
4. Meanwhile, heat chap chae in the microwave.
5. When chicken is finished heating, toss chicken pieces in spicy gochujang sauce and enjoy with kimchi.

### **HEATING INSTRUCTIONS: 4+ Servings**

*If frozen, defrost in refrigerator overnight.*

1. Preheat oven to 375°F (350°F convection).

4. Meanwhile, heat chap chae in the microwave.
